- I will be meeting with seniors this week (Wednesday) to review final graduation information. I will also be sending you the same information; this includes State Farm Stadium parking information and day of ceremony instructions. Points of emphasis during our meeting will be
 - Senioritis is real. Please check your child's grades and communicate immediately with the teacher if there is any concern. One of the toughest conversations is informing a family their child may not graduate. Any student with a D or F is required to attend Power Hour.
 - o Rise Lab Students- students should be working on their courses beyond the school day, after school, in the evening and on weekends.
