outside of the regular school day, but are

taught by a certified highly-qualified teacher in the content area, along with 24 hour technical support. Students may register for one full credit or two half credit courses during the school year. The district will offer a full slate of courses, including core content, a variety of electives, five world languages, and several Advanced Placement classes.

Student Expectations

Students will be required to log a minimum of 90 hours in the course

each semester. Students should expect to spend a minimum of 1 hour in the course each school day. Additional time may be needed to complete assignments and exams.

quired to complete two short orientation courses prior to beginning the coursework. The orientation courses are designed to inform students and parents about requirements and expectations for taking online courses, as well as how to navigate through their coursework, submit assignments, take exams, and get any needed help.

Tuition & Course Information

Tuition Rates for courses are as follows: \$150 for half credit courses

\$300 for full credit courses

\$550 for World Language courses

\$800 for AP Courses

Tuition must be paid in full prior to the start of each semester. Tuition for full credit courses can be paid half in fall semester and half in spring semester. A \$50 non-refundable deposit is required at the time of registration. Students may withdraw within the first two weeks without penalty. Students who withdraw after the two-week window will receive a NC on their transcript and no tuition will be refunded. Courses taken outside of the regular school day are not calculated into a student's class rank or GPA.
