



Concurrent Enrollment Fact Sheet

Many students like to take advantage of the additional opportunities available to complete credits towards graduation. In the Agua Fria Union High School District, we encourage our students to take advantage of the online opportunities we offer for original credit for FREE through our Agua Fria Online Program (AFOLP). In an effort to inform students and parents, we would like to provide the following information so that you can make the right educational decision!

**Concurrent enrollment courses are college and high school courses that students take while enrolled in high school. In the AFUHSD, students must receive prior approval before taking a concurrent enrollment course.

HIGH SCHOOL & COLLEGE CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

To qualify for concurrent enrollment at a community college or a university while enrolled in a school in the Agua Fria Union High School District, a student must complete the concurrent enrollment forms to be approved by the high school counselor. The individual college or university may have additional conditions for enrollment that are the responsibility of the student. Students are responsible to provide the high school registrar with an **official** transcript at the completion of the college course.

ONLINE ORIGINAL CREDIT (ODYSSEYWARE)

The Agua Fria Union High School District offers instructional opportunities through the Agua Fria Online Program (AFOLP) using our Odysseyware Online Curriculum. To be eligible to take an Agua Fria Union High School District online course through this program, a student must be enrolled as a "full time" student. All online courses are supervised by an appropriately certified and highly qualified teacher in the content for which the course is assigned, and according to state and federal guidelines. Students who pass an online course will receive a letter grade and are required to take any State required assessment. Online courses for original credit will be taken **OUTSIDE** of the student's regular school day.

HIGH SCHOOL & NON-DISTRICT ONLINE HIGH SCHOOL CONCURRENT ENROLLMENT

Acceptance of transfer credits from sources outside the AFUHSD is not automatic. Coursework from an accredited institution completed outside of the District will be accepted as elective credit. If a student wishes for it to be considered as core credit, he or she must complete an application to take the Challenge Exam for that course within 10 days of receiving notification of accepted credit. A score of 80% or better is required (scores will NOT be rounded up). Students must meet with their counselor and complete a Concurrent Enrollment Form before enrolling in courses outside the AFUHSD. This meeting will review the process that must be followed and inform the District of the concurrent enrollment.
