Testing for Seniors

Important Events

April 1–2: ACT Aspire Testing – Freshmen only

April 9: ACT Testing – Juniors only

April 18 – 21: April Break (no school)

April 30 – May 2: Cumulative exams for Seniors

ACT Aspire Testing – Freshmen only

All Freshmen (9th–graders) will take the State ACT Aspire test on their home campuses on Tuesday, April 1st and Wednesday, April 2nd.

ACT Testing – Juniors only

All Juniors (11th–graders) will take the State ACT test on their home campuses on Wednesday, April 9th.

“April Break”

Attendance will not be taken for Friday, April 18 and Monday, April 21 in observance of April Break. Online students can log in and work on courses during these days. Any work completed will count towards course completion.

Graduation!

By now, you should have heard about the changes made to the graduation ceremony this year (see [the District Webpage](#) for more information). Due to a conflict with the original venue, our district needed to change the location. This has caused a change in the date as well. The new venue is the Desert Diamond Arena and the event will be on Monday, May 12. As AFO Students, you will be graduating with your home campuses. The times for the ceremonies are as follows:

Cumulative Exams

Since the graduation date has been moved up, we need to adjust the days for taking cumulative exams for seniors as well. This is to allow time to verify that you have met the requirements for graduation. The new cumulative exam dates for seniors will be:

- Wednesday, April 30
- Thursday, May 1
- Friday, May 2



These are set days for testing for seniors. The exams will be taken and monitored online. You do not need to schedule a time or go to a campus, just log onto your school-issued Chromebook during the hours of 7:30 am until 2 pm each day.
