

Interest Inventory


Select **Take the FYI** to identify your work-related interests.

Select the set of results (combined or gender-specific) that sound most like you. Then, select **Start Exploring**.




The AFQT is used for military entrance. Discuss this score with a recruiter.

How To Get There

This section contains options for college, work-based learning, military, and government options to help you gain career field entry.



Career Plan

The Career Plan helps you build the action steps required to achieve your goals so you can evaluate your options and decide which path is right for you. Once you add careers to your favorites, you can build multiple plans to help you evaluate the time and resources needed to enter the career of your dreams.

Portfolio

The Portfolio gives you a place to document your achievements and customize your resume so that it stands out.

Calendar

You can track important dates with the Calendar. Tasks can be added when building Career Plans.

Classroom Activities

Classroom activities are designed to bring career exploration into the classroom (regardless of subject matter) so you can apply what you're learning in class to the real world.
