

Good morning Agua Fria Union High School District Families,

The Agua Fria Union High School District Governing Board has approved moving towards opening all District schools in a hybrid model after fall break on October 12, if all health and safety metrics remain positive. We look forward to safely welcoming our students back to their schools.

Details of the hybrid model have not changed since they were originally communicated prior to the start of the school year. Students will attend class in person two days per week, and students will work from home three days per week. Class schedules will be similar to the ones in place now while in remote learning. Only ½ of students will be on campus each day, and students will continue to take only 3 classes at a time to further reduce daily contacts with other students. Safety protocols, including masks for all staff and students, and robust cleaning and a disinfecting program will be in place.

Your student's school will be providing additional details regarding safety protocols and the hybrid model as this transition approaches. At the beginning of the school year families were asked to select whether they would like to participate in the hybrid model when it was safe to do so, or whether they would like for their students to continue full online remote learning for the remainder of the semester in what we are now calling the flex model. At that time about 91% chose the hybrid model. We understand that a lot has happened and changed over the past several weeks, and that some families may have different feelings now than they did at that time. Therefore we would like to allow families to update their choice of what learning model is best for their student. **ALL** families should click on the link below to complete the learning model survey.

If you do not complete the survey your student will automatically be placed in the hybrid model when it begins.

This choice is for the remainder of the first semester. We will re-evaluate and review options for the second semester.
