The Agua Fria Union High School District serves the communities of Avondale, Goodyear, Litchfield Park and Buckeye, along with the White Tanks residential area and a portion of the Luke Air Force Base housing. Agriculture, aerospace, retail businesses and the Luke Air Force Base provide the major economic base in the district. Avondale Elementary and Litchfield Elementary are the feeder school districts from which we receive most of our students. The district is composed of a diversity of cultural and ethnic groups. Persons of Caucasian, Hispanic, Black, Native American and Asian heritage make up the greatest portion of the district's population. Agua Fria Union High School District has a strong commitment to develop and institute programs that offer the opportunity for, and equal access to, quality education for the diverse and growing student population.

Curriculum:

The courses offered in the Agua Fria Union High School District have been designed to challenge students; these courses are rigorous and provide relevance. Advanced Placement and International Baccalaureate classes are specifically designed as the most rigorous in the District's curriculum and are geared for the most highly motivated students. AP and IB classes follow a nationally/internationally recognized, collegiate level curriculum. Depending upon the final grade on an Advanced Placement or International Baccalaureate exam, credit for these classes may be transferable to the college of a student's choice. AP courses are offered in the following areas: AP English Literature, AP English Language, AP Biology,

AP Environmental, AP Chemistry, AP Physics Mechanics, AP Physics Electricity, AP Human Geography, AP Psychology, AP Art History, AP Calculus AB, AP Calculus AB/BC, AP Statistics, AP World History, AP American History, AP Government/Free Enterprise, AP Art Studio, AP Computer Science Principles: Coding I, AP Computer Science Principles: Coding II, and AP Spanish. The IB Curriculum consists of IB Film SL/HL, IB Spanish AB Initio, SL/HL, IB Psychology SL/HL, IB Chemistry SL, IB Biology HL, IB Physics SL, IB History HL, IB Math SL/HL, IB Math Application and Interpretation SL/HL, IB Math Analysis and Approaches SL/HL, IB English HL, IB Sports, Exercise, & Health Science SL, IB Business Management, IB Visual Arts SL/HL, IB Theory of Knowledge. We offer a total of 11 Honors classes, 20 AP classes, and 15 IB classes.

Dual Enrollment:

Millennium High School has a partnership with Estrella Mountain Community College, Rio Salado Community College, and Grand Canyon University which allows lower division (100-200 level) college courses to be taught at the high school during regular school hours. These courses are counted towards high school requirements, giving you the opportunity to earn both high school and college credit for the same courses. Upon satisfactory completion of these courses, students can use the credits toward a degree at EMCC / Rio Salado/GCU or transfer the credits to other colleges and universities. 2023-2024 Dual Enrollment courses offered are: Culinary Arts I & II, Sports Medicine I and II, AP US History, AP World History, Spanish II, Honors Spanish III, Algebra III, Marketing Principles, AP Calculus A/B, B/C and AP Physics Mechanics.

Grading, Grade Point Average and Class Rank:

Class rank is determined by weighted GPA. If more than one student has the same GPA, he or she will be awarded the same rank number.
