REGULATION

COLLECTION OF MONEY / FOOD TICKETS

Suggested Meal Procedures:

- A. Students who are classified as "free" based on income, state aid or direct certification will receive all meals, breakfast and lunch, at no cost to the family.
- B. Students who are classified as "reduced" will pay a partial fee for each meal consumed.
- C. Students who are classified as "paid" will be charged for each meal consumed according to the above schedule.
- D. Any student who is classified as "reduced" or "paid" and whose lunch meal account has been depleted will be granted up to two (2) additional full meals pending replenishment of the account. When the account reaches two (2) meals with payment in arrears, the student will be served an alternate meal of a peanut butter and jelly sandwich, fruit and milk in lieu of the full meal, for which no charge will be made.
- E. Parents will be notified on a regular basis of any deficiencies in their financial liability to the District. If a parent/guardian discloses difficulty in paying for reduced or full price meals, or has developed a history of late payments or negative account balances, and application for free or reduced-price meals is to be provided.
- F. All deficient meal accounts should be brought current at the end of the school year. However, unpaid meal charges may be carried over at the end of the school year as delinquent debt and collection efforts may continue into the new school year.
