## **Covid Protocols for School Year 21-22**

(subject to change based on updated guidance)

### **Masks**

- Wearing masks is optional beginning July 1, 2021 and for the 21-22 school year. This includes bus transportation.
- CDC recommends masks be worn indoors by individuals who are not fully vaccinated.
- In support of individuals who elect to wear a face covering, schools will continue to provide masks to students, staff and visitors who request one.

### **Vaccination**

### **Daily Health Screenings**

- Daily health screenings are no longer required for staff, students, or visitors. Anyone not feeling well should stay home.
- Hand sanitizer will continue to be provided on campus, along with encouragement for consistent hand washing and covering the mouth and nose when coughing or sneezing.

### **Physical Distancing**

- In alignment with CDC recommendations, physical distancing will be encouraged in appropriate settings.

### **Positive Test Result/Symptoms/Close-Contact Exposure**

- Quarantine and isolation guidelines from Maricopa County Department of Public Health will be followed. Specific instructions will be given to individuals who test positive, have symptoms or close-contact exposure.
- Each school site will continue to have a designated Covid supervisor.
  - If a household member tests positive, the student should not come to school until speaking with the covid supervisor.
  - If symptoms are consistent with Covid-19, testing is recommended.
