Beginning August 17, 2020, Agua Fria High School students who need a supervised, remote workspace may reserve a seat on campus. **Reservations are required.** Students must know their five-digit ID number. Student walk-ins cannot be accommodated. Additionally, students will be responsible for their own transportation as buses will not be available, with the exception of ESS students whose transportation services are identified in their IEPs. Please click on the link at the bottom of this letter by Thursday, August 13, 2020, to reserve a spot for your child.

The school will provide supervision for students while they participate in remote learning to mitigate less than optimal remote learning environments at students' homes, including intermittent or unreliable internet or excessive distractions. This also creates an opportunity for pullout support services for students with IEPs.

For the first time in the history of the common school, enforcing a safe and orderly environment has a greater and more profound purpose. To be clear, we are adhering to all CDC safety guidelines and protocols; thus, we will not tolerate a breach of protocol. We will have zero tolerance for noncompliance with protocols for a safe and orderly remote learning environment in our gymnasiums. Any student found out of compliance with established guidelines will be sent home immediately. Returning to on-site remote learning will only be permitted following a parent and student meeting with the principal to correct any confusion and obtain student and parent commitment of compliance. Please read the following information carefully.

- 1. Student Work Area: Students will be provided a workspace in one of the gymnasiums where they will be supervised by the Agua Fria staff. Students may not leave their workspace during the school day except under the direction of staff to use facilities.
- 2. Arrival/Departure Procedures: All students must report to the north side of the New Gym entering off Dysart Road between 7:55 a.m. and 8:10 a.m. Parents dropping off students will exit to the west and south out the student parking lot onto Riley Drive. Students driving themselves will park on the basketball courts north of the football field. Students will not be allowed in more than ten minutes late. This is the same location where students should be picked up promptly at 3:05.

- 3. <u>Health Protocols</u>: Students must complete a daily health screening, and MASKS ARE REQUIRED at all times while on campus except when eating. Masks are to be worn covering the nose and mouth.
- 4. <u>Required School Items</u>: Students must arrive with a fully charged Chromebook, chargers, and headphones or earbuds every day in order to log into their remote classrooms. Any student without a charged Chromebook, charger, or headphones/earbuds will be sent home as we cannot support learning without the provided technology. No other items should be brought on campus.
- 5. <u>Work Requirements</u>: Students not logged in and engaged in class will be sent home.
- 6. <u>Breakfast/Lunch</u>: Students will be able to purchase breakfast and lunch which will be delivered to them. Students qualifying for free meals will still receive free breakfast and lunch. Students may also bring their own sack lunch. Students will eat at their workspace.
- 7. <u>Water</u>: Students need to bring their own water bottle. No OUTSIDE drinks such as QT, McDonald's, Dutch Bros, Starbucks, etc., will be permitted. They will be confiscated and discarded. In accordance with health and safety guidelines, we have disabled all drinking fountains that are not touchless.
- 8. <u>Restrooms</u>: For the safety of all students and staff, students will be escorted to the restroom one at a time to ensure compliance with all safety protocols, such as social distancing and applying hand sanitizer after exiting the restroom. There will be no socializing.
- 9. <u>Dress Code</u>: We will enforce the school dress code so students should dress appropriately. No pajamas, lounge pants, slippers, blankets, etc. Please note the gyms are usually cold, so dress accordingly. Masks and face coverings must also adhere to dress code regulations. Bandanas are not permitted as face coverings.
- 10. <u>Behavior</u>: Students who are disruptive to the remote learning work space environment will be sent home. There will be very limited interaction among students. Talking will be limited to interaction with their remote classes so students can focus on their academic studies without excessive noise similar to a library environment.
- 11. <u>Cell Phones</u>: Students may not use cell phones during the school day. Parents needing to contact their student should call the front office or email their student.
