The 2015 bond provided safety enhancements, invested in technology to allow us to push our district to go 1:1 where all students receive their own chromebooks, and provided funds to build our fifth high school, Canyon View, to support our growing community.

Moving forward...

The funding requested by the 2019 election will address school safety and fund critical repairs. The District has school buildings that are now over 60 years old and in desperate need of renovation. Other areas in need of renovation include restroom facilities, air conditioning and HVAC systems, and other major systems that have outlived their useful lives. These areas will be renovated with modern efficient systems.

ABOUT THE 2019 BOND

A bond provides the district additional funding to use for capital items, such as new buildings, additions or renovations to buildings, school buses, equipment and technology.
