Congratulations to Catherine Broski for being named a 2020 Flinn Scholar! Catherine is one of 19 students to be named for this prestigious scholarship award which includes: A full ride scholarship to one of Arizona's state universities, funding for a three-week summer seminar after the Scholar's freshman year and for at least one additional international study abroad experience. This scholarship is very competitive, and out of 1,014 applicants Catherine was one of the 19 winners!

Catherine was chosen not just for her superb academics, but because of her community service and advocacy. To name a few things Catherine organized a peaceful gathering to show love and support for Parkland shooting victims, worked as a State Director for March For Our Lives Arizona, and led the charge for the Agua Fria Union School Board to pass a resolution to support school safety and mental health. She also attended HOBY leadership seminar and started the West Valley's first ever CLeW (Community Leadership Workshop). During the 2019 CLeW Catherine and her team partnered with Gathering Humanity to fill over 500 backpacks for refugees. The 2020 CLeW was postponed however Catherine is leading the way to complete the community service project. For this project the CLeW Committee is working with HYC (Homeless Youth Connection) to ensure each 2020 graduating senior in our community who experienced homelessness will receive a graduation card.
