
AFUHSD Summer School Opportunities Incoming Freshmen Programs

Freshmen Transition Classes

Incoming Freshmen can experience academic success and earn up to **0.5 elective credits** through participation in one of the three Summer School programs offered at Desert Edge High School.

Summer Success: Students attend English and Math classes that establish foundational content skills, introduce the Advisory Program, establish effective study skills and discuss setting college and career readiness learning goals.

Summer Academy: Designed for students who have been in Gifted or Talented programs, or who have successfully completed Honors middle school classes. This academy emphasizes project based learning in English and Math, as well as cultivates collaboration and leadership skills.

Foundations: Is a **teacher recommended** program for incoming freshmen who need additional support in foundational reading and math skills. Students who are recommended for this program by their 8th grade teacher will receive a letter indicating placement in Foundations.

Each program consists of a single class in English & Math that will count as an Elective (0.5 credit total).

Computer Science Discoveries

Available to Incoming Freshmen and rising Sophomores. Every 21st century student should have the opportunity to learn computer science. Software jobs, and related skills, are increasingly in demand and allow for tremendous workplace flexibility. The purpose of a high school education is college and career readiness, and this class is a pathway for students to be prepared for both.

Students may earn 0.5 elective credits.
