CAPSTONE PROJECT

A process in which students pursue independent research on a question or problem of their choice, engage with the scholarly debates in the relevant disciplines, and - with the guidance of a faculty mentor - produce a substantial project that reflects deep understanding.

DIPLOMA SEAL APPLICATION

In order for a Conservatory Student to receive recognition as a Conservatory graduate, the student artist must complete the following requirements. Upon the completion of the requirements the student will receive recognition by certificate and the Arizona State Seal of Arts Proficiency.

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Step 1: Signature Program Completion Verification (Meet with Counselor)

Requirements

For an Arizona student to qualify for the seal, they must complete a Seal of Arts Proficiency Pathway and successfully graduate from an Arizona district public or charter school. The pathway is designed to celebrate students who complete a rigorous, standards-based, and high-quality arts education course of study, provided to all LEAs including the most remote and rural communities.

To qualify for the Arizona State Seal of Arts Proficiency, a student will complete:

- 1. A final GPA of 3.0 or 4.0 in each qualifying arts/career and technical education (CTE) course.
- 2. 4 minimum credit requirements in one of the following ways:
 - a. A minimum of <u>4</u> credits in <u>one artistic discipline</u>: (dance, music, theatre, visual arts or media arts)

OR

b. <u>3</u> credits in <u>one artistic discipline</u>, and <u>1</u> qualifying creative industries <u>CTE</u> credit or separate artistic discipline.

OR

- c. <u>2</u> credits in <u>one artistic discipline</u>, and <u>2</u> credits in a qualifying creative industries <u>CTE</u> class or a separate artistic discipline.
- 3. 60 hours for 2022 and then 80 hours of arts related extracurricular activities by 2023.
- 4. A student capstone project
